

1. Plants Have Memory (Mimosa Pudica Study - Monica Gagliano, 2014)

Monica Gagliano, an evolutionary biologist, conducted experiments on the Mimosa pudica (the "sensitive plant"), which folds its leaves when touched. She trained the plants to stop reacting to harmless stimuli by repeatedly dropping them in a controlled way that caused no harm. Over time, the plants "learned" to stop closing their leaves, suggesting they remembered the experience and adjusted their response. Even weeks later, the plants retained this "memory" without a nervous system.

2. Plants Respond to Human Emotions (Cleve Backster's Polygraph Tests, 1966)

Cleve Backster, a former CIA polygraph expert, attached a lie detector to a plant and found that it produced electrical responses similar to a human experiencing emotions. The most famous part of his experiment? When he merely thought about burning the plant's leaves, the polygraph registered a dramatic reaction—suggesting that the plant somehow sensed his intent.
